

Brief Summary - CF Case 1:99-cv-00550-ECH

Motion to intervene filed October 15, 2007

"The current complaint(s) in the captioned, consolidated case concern issues based on the duty of the Defendant to collect and pay royalty on oil and gas production, to pay over trust funds and interest to the Osage, including proper payment of monies due from land sales subject to treaties and statutes, for interest due on other sums and for damages from the loss of Osage trust account monies. Plaintiff's complaints allege the Defendant has breached its fiduciary duty in the mismanagement, investment and payment of Osage trust funds."

Amend Complaint filed October 15, 2007

"Bring and prosecute this action as a "class action" for themselves and as a representative of and on behalf of all other owners of Osage headrights..."
